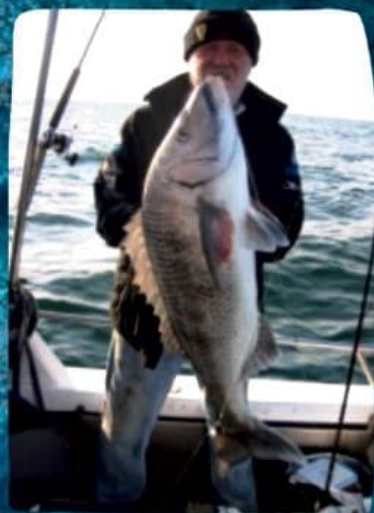

WELCOME TO THE SOUTHERN TIP OF AFRICA

A JOURNEY THROUGH STRUISBAAI & CAPE AGULHAS



At the southernmost tip of Africa, where the warm Indian Ocean meets the icy Atlantic in a dramatic swirl, lies a region rich in maritime history, cultural heritage, and natural wonder. This is Cape Agulhas, a rugged and beautiful stretch of coastline that captivates the soul.

One of the area's most haunting and iconic landmarks is the Meisho Maru No. 38 shipwreck. The Japanese fishing vessel ran aground in 1982 and now lies rusted and broken along the shoreline near Agulhas, a stark reminder of the treacherous seas that have claimed many ships over centuries.

For those intrigued by maritime history, the Shipwreck Museum in Bredasdorp offers a deeper dive. Housed in a beautiful historic building, it showcases relics from shipwrecks

along the treacherous Agulhas coastline. Old anchors, cannons, navigational instruments, and personal belongings of shipwreck victims tell stories of peril, hope, and survival.

A short drive away lies the village of Arniston, home to the dramatic Arniston Cave. Accessible only at low tide, this massive sea cave has been shaped by millennia of ocean erosion. Inside, the echo of waves reverberates off its ancient walls, creating a cathedral-like atmosphere that evokes awe and quiet reflection.

Closer to daily life is Struisbaai Harbour, a hub of the local community. Brightly painted fishing boats line the dock, seagulls wheel above, and fishermen haul in their catch. Here, visitors might encounter the area's most beloved local Parrie, the Stingray. Gentle and curious, Parrie is a resident stingray known for gliding through the shallows and interacting with people. He has become a symbol of the harbour's charm and a unique ambassador for marine conservation.

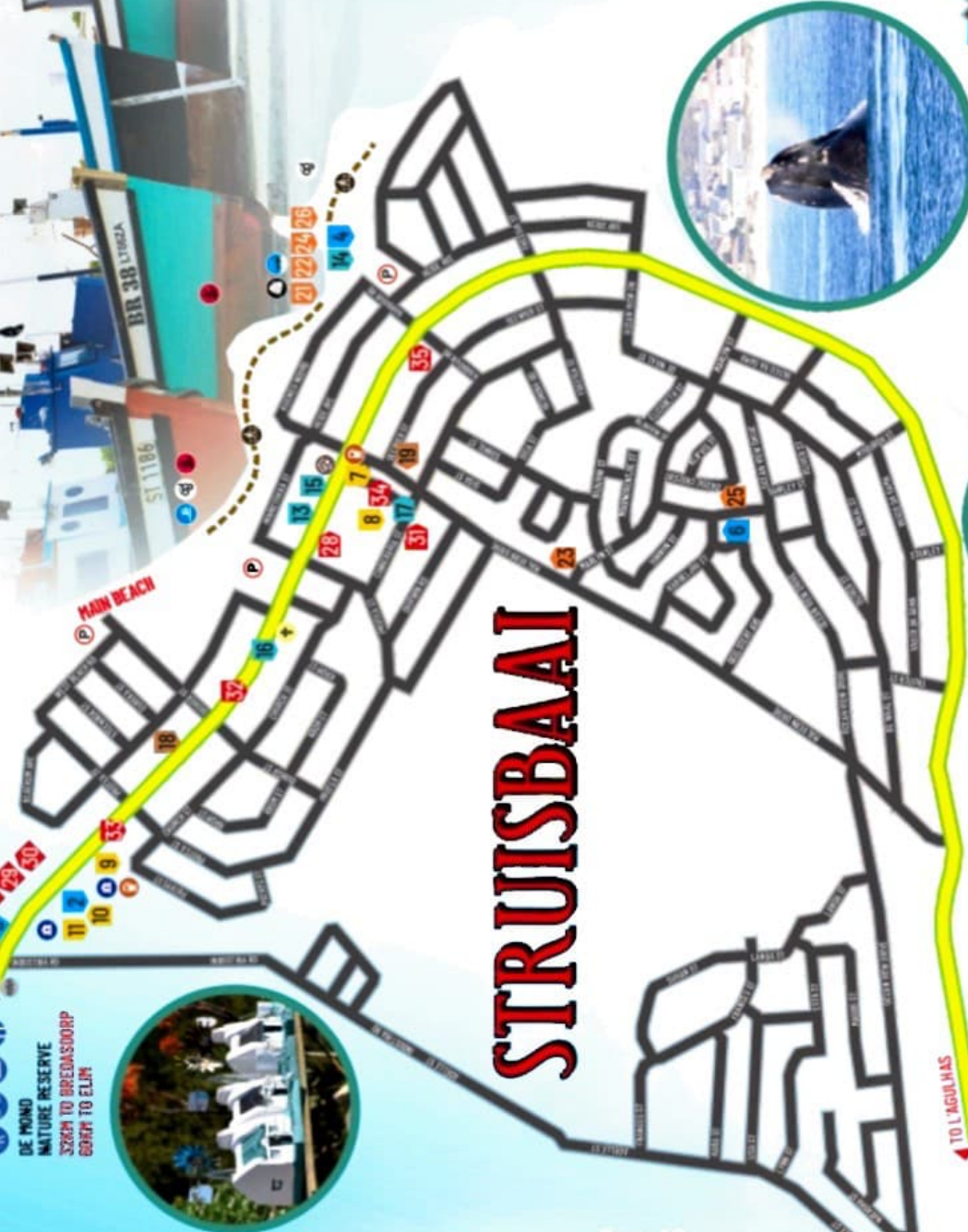

Tournament Rules

1. General Event Information

1. The Championships headquarters will be The Harbour Café, Struisbaai.
2. The Championships shall be fished to EFSA rules governing at the time of the event unless otherwise stated.
3. All competitors must be in possession of a valid South African fishing permit.
4. Line Championship will be fished the First two days of the tournament (9th & 10th)
5. Boat Championship (All Tackle) will be fished the Last three days of the tournament (11th to 13th)
6. The Combined scores of the line class & the Boat Championship will determine the overall winners of the five (5) day tournament.
7. A husband and wife/partner or parent and child may apply to be drawn on the same boat. A formal request must accompany the entry form.
8. Anglers must assemble at The Harbour Café at the appointed time each day. (See Programme of Events.)
9. Daily results will be posted at the EFSA HQ – The Harbour Café each evening.

2. Boat Draw & Fishing Captain

1. The boat draw will take place in public not later than one calendar month before the event.
2. Fishing positions will be drawn on board daily.

3. A Fishing Captain will be appointed for each boat. Their duties include:

- Liaising with the boat skipper
- Ensuring championship rules are adhered to
- Observance of start/finish times
- Conducting the draw for fishing positions

The Fishing Captain must:

- Ensure the boat sheet is completed, signed and returned to the weigh station
- Complete Fish Record Cards and Boat Master Cards
- Ensure all anglers have signed both
- Complete a "Dispute Form" if needed and hand it to the shore officer upon arrival in harbour

4. Fishing Areas & Weather

1. The organising committee shall direct the fishing areas daily.
2. Prevailing weather may confine the fleet to the harbour/bay area.
3. EFSA rules relating to boat breakdowns shall apply if necessary.

5. Fishing Conduct & Equipment

5.1 General Rules

1. No lines may be in the water before the call of "lines down".
2. Each competitor must ensure every fish caught is acknowledged and recorded by the skipper before continuing fishing.
3. Fish must be returned to the water immediately after verifying & recording.
4. A foul-hooked fish does not count and must be returned immediately.
5. A fish hooked by two anglers in front of the gill cover does not count; if only one has hooked it correctly, that angler may claim it.
6. Casting must be under-arm and away from the boat; terminal tackle must remain outside the boat during the cast.
7. Wire main line is prohibited.
8. Competitors may have one rod fully assembled and a second rod assembled to the tackle clip (maximum two rods).
9. Anglers may call for a landing net. Gaffing is not permitted except in exceptional circumstances.

5.2 Hooks, Lures & Terminal Tackle

1. Only single baited hooks are permitted (general championships).
2. No artificial lures, pirks or jigs are allowed.
3. Treble hooks are not permitted.

6. Bait Rules

1. Bait will be supplied daily to each competitor and may not be shared.
2. The only additional bait allowed is bait caught by the competitor that same day.
3. Bait may not be retained after each day.
4. Size-able fish may be used as bait after being measured and recorded, however, the tail has to be removed immediately.
5. 3 x 1 KG Sardines & 1 x 1 KG Chocka per angler per day.

7. Scoring System

1. The Percentage System will be used for both championships.
2. Daily boat winners receive 100 points; all others receive a percentage of the boat winner's total.
3. Tie-breakers – Boat Championships: (All Tackle)
 - Highest total points
 - Then highest number of fish
 - Then greatest number of species
4. Tie-breakers – Line Class Category:
 - Fewest number of fish
 - If still tied, greatest number of species

8. Verification & Scoring Responsibilities

1. Each competitor is responsible for ensuring their scores are correct before signing.
2. EFSA South Africa scorecard will apply.

9. Protests & Disputes

1. A Protest Committee will be appointed.
2. Protest Protocol:
 - Protests about a day's fishing must be submitted to the Chairman by 19:00 the same day.
 - Protests relating to results not resolved must be submitted in writing by 07:00 the next day.

10. Dress Code

Correct dress must be worn at all official functions, including:

- Standing Committee meeting
- Welcome Reception
- Prize Giving
- Gala Dinners

Correct dress = International Uniform or smart casual with tie.

No denims, jeans, T-shirts or trainers.

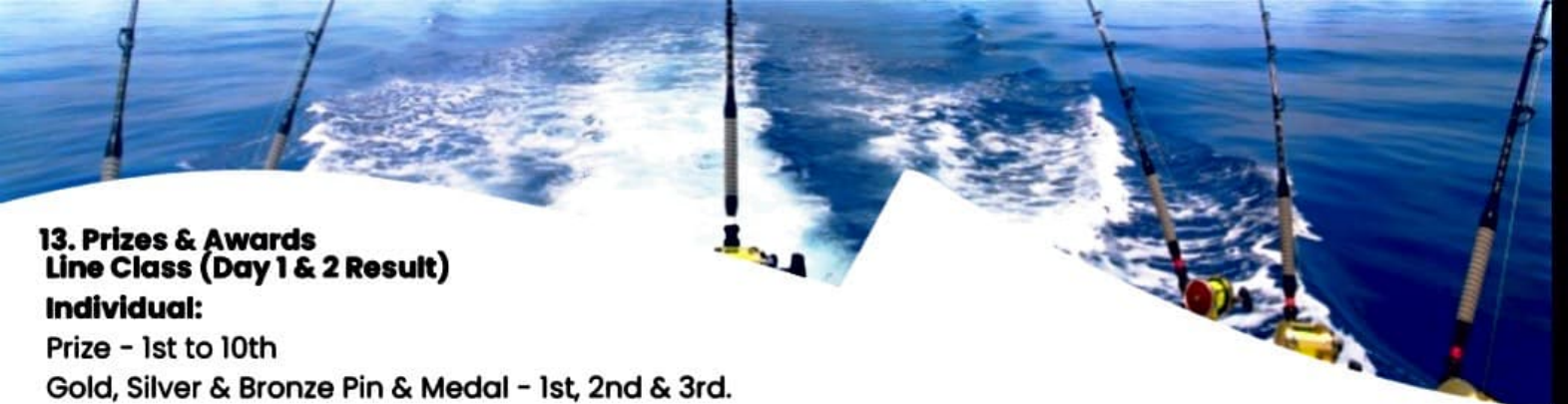
Failure to comply results in forfeiture of receiving prizes publicly.

11. All Tackle Rules (Only)

- A maximum of two single hooks may be used (EFSA Rule 2.22).
- All fish must be measured and released, unless used for bait.
- All Tackle Tournament will be fished the LAST three days. (11th to the 13th of November 2026)

12. Line Class Rules (Only)

1. Will be fished the FIRST two days. (9th to 10th November 2026)
2. Only the line provided may be used.
3. The line on a competitor's reel may be tested at any time.
4. Maximum one single baited hook permitted.
5. A competitor with a big fish on has right of way; others must remove their lines if asked.
6. Leader length:
 - Total length incl. trace: max 6 metres
 - Leader alone: max 4.5 metres
7. Only fish listed on the score card will count.
8. Fish sizes/points assessed by the boat captain where applicable.
9. Fishing may be anchored or drifting.
10. Line Class Championship Winner = highest percentage score over two days.
 - If tied → fewest fish
 - If still tied → greatest number of species
11. In case of bad weather, general championship rules apply and two hooks are permitted.

Prize - 1st to 3rd.

Prize - 1st to 3rd.

Gold, Silver & Bronze Medal - 1st, 2nd & 3rd.

Team of Two (Entry €10 per person, enter at registration):

Prize - 1st to 3rd.

Gold, Silver & Bronze Medal - 1st, 2nd & 3rd.

Longest Fish:

Gold Medal & Prize.
